San Antonio and Rodeo Austin tour guide sign ups were submitted. The 4-H dance committee provided an update. Under New business: Council officer applications are due March 15th. Ellen Carroll moved that we do elections electronically and Brady Masur seconded. The motion passed. Award applications are posted on the website and are due May 18th by noon. Interviews will be Friday, June 17th. Scholarship applications are due May 18th by noon and interviews will be Friday, June 17th. District 10 Spring roundup contests will take place April 19-23 in Kerrville/Fredericksburg with registrations opening in late March or early April. District 10 4-H photography contest will be open February 1st-21st and registration is \$15 a person. The Bastrop Area livestock show rabbit validation will be postponed. Elgin Livestock Show will be open to the whole county again next year and the new show meeting will be in April. Smithville livestock show will be April 22-23. Texas 4-H congress will be held July 17-20. Upcoming dates are on the back of the agenda. Ellen made the motion to adjourn, Luke Bauer seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 pm.
