INFORMATION, INSTRUCTIONS, & IMPORTANT DATES

Purpose:

The purpose of these Scholarships is to assist students beginning higher education and to recognize outstanding students in Bastrop County 4-H. Applicants should have a sound academic background, exhibit leadership qualities, be an active 4-H member, demonstrate financial need, be of good character and have participated in school and/or community activities. Applicants are considered without regard to socioeconomic level, race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, gender, marital or veteran status or the presence of medical condition or handicap.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be considered for this scholarship, an applicant must:

1. Be actively involved in Bastrop County 4-H, attended high school in Bastrop County, and be a member of a Bastrop County 4-H Club.
2. Be enrolled in a recognized vocational school or college.
3. Maintain a grade point average above the level that would result in scholastic probation.

Application Procedure:

An applicant will be given consideration for the scholarship when all the following have been received at the County Extension Office on or before **12:00 Noon on Thursday, June 1, 2023:**

1. A completed application (this form)
2. A transcript for all academic work, grade-point average, and college admissions scores
3. Current year 4-H Recordbook
4. Recorded Video Interview

Recorded Video Interview Instructions:

Please record your answers to the questions listed below in a 5-7 minute video. We would like you to upload the video to YouTube and submit the video link via email to MLMickelson@ag.tamu.edu. You may set your video as unlisted (not private) to ensure privacy of your video which will allow only those with the link to view the upload. Please make sure to introduce yourself, as well.

Video Interview Questions:

1. Introduce yourself and your main 4-H projects.
2. How have your 4-H project experiences prepared you for the future?
3. What are some of the leadership positions you've held and leadership activities you've led?
4. In what ways have you been a positive influence on your peers?
5. What are some ways you've helped your county/community?
6. What is the greatest life skill you feel you have gained through your involvement in 4-H?

The scholarship money will be awarded to the recipient(s) upon presentation of a current registration receipt from the school of higher education or a check will be made out to the school on behalf of the student.
