All pigs, including registered/crossbred gilts, to be shown at the 2024 State Fair Livestock Show or Heart of Texas Livestock Show must be validated. The cost is \$20.00 per head. Please complete this form and return it with payment to the Bastrop County Extension Office by 12:00 Noon on Wednesday, April 03, 2024.

Validation will take place from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM on Wednesday, June 12, 2024, at the Ken Estepp Show Barn

Please note that all 4-H/FFA orders must be submitted using this form; if a family finds that more tags are needed, please submit an additional form. Additionally, NO refunds will be given on tag orders. Please also remember that purchasing a validation tag does NOT enter an exhibitor in a livestock show.

Late State Fair Swine Validation Tag Orders will be accepted after April 03rd up until 12:00 PM on Wednesday, May 01, 2024, at the increased cost of \$23.00 per tag. Payment is due at the time of submission.
